

RULES FOR VISITING
the Prince's Stables in Pszczyna

1. The Prince's Stables exhibition in Pszczyna ("Stables") can be visited without a guide - individually or in organised groups.
2. An organised group visiting the Stables cannot be larger than 25 people (including carers, guide, etc.)
3. The number of tickets sold in one day may be limited.
4. For conservation and organisational reasons, the route of the tour can be changed.
5. Persons intoxicated or behaving in a way that endangers the safety of the exhibition and the collection, disrupting the viewing of the exhibition by other visitors, violating generally accepted norms of behaviour in public places and people failing to comply with these Rules will not be allowed into the Stables.
6. Visitors are required to leave large bags, backpacks, umbrellas, prams, etc., in the Stables' cloakroom.
7. Do not bring and consume food, drinks, do not smoke in the exhibition area at the Stables.
8. Do not touch the exhibits at the Stables, climb the ropes and move outside the designated route.
9. Due to the safety of visitors, please do not enter into the Stables in high heel shoes.
10. It is forbidden to bring animals into the Stables, with the exception of guide dogs of blind people.
11. Photos and videos can be taken only without a tripod and all kinds of artificial light sources. Captured images and video footage are intended solely for personal use and their further publication and distribution in any form without permission of the Museum is not permitted.
12. During the tour, please do not use mobile phones. Please turn off or mute your phone.
